

**Scenario No. 5. WMT Day . Examination Commissions at school. Examination Patrols outside the school. Oral examinations.**

**Duration:** 5-6 hours.

**Place:** Examination Commissions - school hall, Examination Patrols – outside the school.

**Participants:** school students, school workers, guests, Media.

**Who conduct examinations:** Examination Commissions, Local Coordinator.

**Number of Examination Commissions:** determined by a teacher.

**Examination form:** oral answers (on examination sheets).

**To prepare:**

1.	Examination sheets – one sheet per student.	Organizers Zone

4.	Watch or stopwatch – one watch/stopwatch per Commission.

6.	MT EXPERT cards – for those, who will pass the examination.	Organizers Zone
7.	Tables of multiplication table - to check whether the answers are correct.	

**Program:**

No.	Subject	Time	Implementation
1.	Opening ceremony.	8.00-8.15	Headteacher announces: <i>World Multiplication Table Day starts today</i> . Coordinator describes purposes of the event.
2.	Examinations – Commissions.	8.20-11.30	Examination Commission sits by one bench. There are examination sheets in the basket.
			3.1. Examinee gets examination sheet from the basket. 3.2. Examiner announces: START! and turns on the stopwatch. 3.3. Examinee reads examples from the sheet and gives oral answer on each example. 3.4. Examination Commission supervises exams: - Passed examination – when all given answers within 3 minutes are correct. - Not passed examination – when at least one given answer within 3 minutes is incorrect. 3.5. Each person, who passed an exam receives the MT EXPERT title. Examination Commission gives successful examinee high five or a dap. 3.6. Not passed examination can be repeated after an 1 hour.
3.	Examinations – Patrols.	11.30-13.00	Examination Patrols – under supervision of an adult person! – conduct exams for those who are willing to answer. For example – in the park or during the visit in City Hall.
4.	Summary of the event.	14.00	Coordinator describes summary of the event on the school board: number of examinees, people, who passed an examination.
