Duration: 45 minutes.

Place: classroom.

Participants: students in one classroom.

Who conduct examinations: teams of 3-4 students.

Examination Commission (3 people) and a teacher who supervise the examinations.

Examination form: oral answers (on examination sheets).

Props

- 1. Examination sheets* one sheet per student
- 2. Pens one pen per student
- 3. Basket for drawing
- **4.** Watch or stopwatch one watch/stopwatch per team
- 5. MT Examiners IDs* for the Examination Commission (3 people)
- **6.** MT EXPERT cards* for those, who will pass the examination
- 7. Tables of multiplication table to check whether the answers are correct
- 8. A few puzzles chosen by a teacher*

Program

	5 min.	Teacher announces the lesson topic: "WMTD"	Teacher describes purposes of the event. Examination Commission explains examination rules. Students form teams of 3–4 people. Each team chooses a captain. Teams sit at one or two connected benches.
	5 min.	Drawing	There are examination sheets in the basket. Commission goes with a basket from team to team. Each captain chooses sheets for own team (one sheet per team member!).
	10-15 min.	Egzaminy ustne w zespołach	 Examinee gets examination sheet from the team captain. Captain reads first question from the sheet and other student starts the stopwatch. Examinee gives an oral answer. Captain reads other questions from the sheet and examinee gives oral answers. Examination Commission supervises exams: Passed examination - when all given answers within 3 minutes are correct. Not passed examination - when at least one given answer within 3 minutes is incorrect.
	10-15 min.	Checking the answers. Solving puzzles	Examination Commission collects sheets, than checks all answers and determine who passed the examinations. Other students solve chosen puzzles.
	10 min.	Announcing results of the examination.	Examination Commission announces results of the exams. Each person, who passed an exam receives the MT EXPERT title. Examination Commission gives successful examinee high five or a dap.
