Duration: 45 minutes.**Place:** classroom.**Participants:** students in one classroom.**Who conduct examinations:** Examination Commission (3 people) and a teacher.**Examination form:** written answers on the examination sheets.

Props

1. Examination sheets* – one sheet per student
2. Pens – one pen per student
3. Basket – for drawing
4. Watch or stopwatch – to measure the exam duration
5. MT Examiners IDs* – for the Examination Commission (3 people)
6. MT EXPERT cards* – for those, who will pass the examination
7. A few puzzles chosen by a teacher*

Program

5 min	Teacher announces the lesson topic: "WMTD"	Teacher describes purposes of the event. Examination Commission explains examination rules.
5 min.	Drawing	There are examination sheets in the basket. Commission goes with the basket from bench to bench. Each student chooses one sheet (only one!) and write down own initials or Name and Surname on it.
10 min.	Written examination	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher announces: <i>Start!</i> and starts the stopwatch 2. Students write down their answers on examination sheets. 3. Teacher announces: <i>End of exam!</i> after about 4 minutes. 4. Students put pens aside.
15 min.	Checking the answers. Solving puzzles	Examination Commission collects sheets, than checks all answers and determine who passed the examination. Other students solve chosen puzzles.
10 min.	Announcing results of the examination.	Examination Commission announces results of the exam. Each person, who passed an exam receives the MT EXPERT title. Examination Commission gives successful examinee high five or a dap.
